WARSAW OLD TOWN TOUR WITH ROYAL CASTLE

Duration: 4 hours

Enjoy this great opportunity to get general impression of the Poland's capital. We will pass the Old Town that was completely destroyed during WWII and rebuilt so painstakingly that in 1980 it was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. You will see The Royal Castle with its square residence of monarchs from 1596 to 1795, as well as the residence of the Polish President in 1918. Also you can see the first secular monument in our country, King Sigismund III Column. St. John's Cathedral, Gothic church and witness to some of the most important events in the history of Poland with sarcophagi containing the remains of eminent Poles. After you will arrive to The Old Town Market Square and Barbican. We will stroll along The Royal Route, with superb aristocratic residences and famous monuments, including the Holy Cross Church containing urns with the hearts of Fryderyk Chopin and Wladyslaw Reymont, the first Polish winner of the Nobel Prize for Literature. Other important place of interest that you will see it's the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Monument to the Warsaw Uprising of 1944.

KRAKÓW - Old Town & Wawel Royal Castle

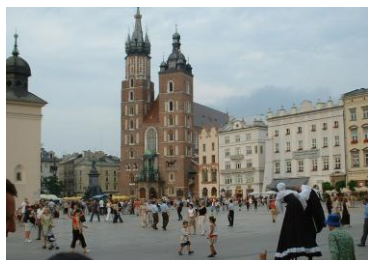
Duration: 16 hours

We recommend using the train to get to Krakow. The journey by train will last 2h50.

This tour gives the best opportunity to get to know the rich history of Cracow and its' most interesting monuments. Following the Royal Route we will start our visit by the Barbican and St. Florian's gate which were a part of the defense system of medieval Cracow and today are the only preserved remains of imposing city walls. A walk up Floriańska street will lead us to the very busy heart of Cracow, Main Market Square, dominated by the Cloth Hall and St. Mary's basilica, world famous for the masterpiece of gothic sculpture, the main altar made by Wit Stoss in XV century. After visiting the church we will proceed to the university district where we will admire the courtyard of the oldest part of the Jagiellonian University, the Collegium Maius. From here we will proceed to the Wawel Hill where from Cracow's castle complex overlooks the city. From the year 1000, when the bishopric of Cracow was established, Wawel has been at the heart of Poland's history. Located here, the Royal Castle has been the seat of Poland's kings from the 11th to the early 17th century. Today this is one of the most visited places in Cracow each summer overrun by tourists attracted by rich collection of royal tapestries, tombs of kings buried in the cathedral and by mysterious dragon's cave lying at the foot of the hill. Accompanied by our guide you will visit the interiors of the Wawel Castle and the royal cathedral, highlighting all important historical details of this pearl of Renaissance architecture.

During your visit a break for lunch in the local restaurant.
